

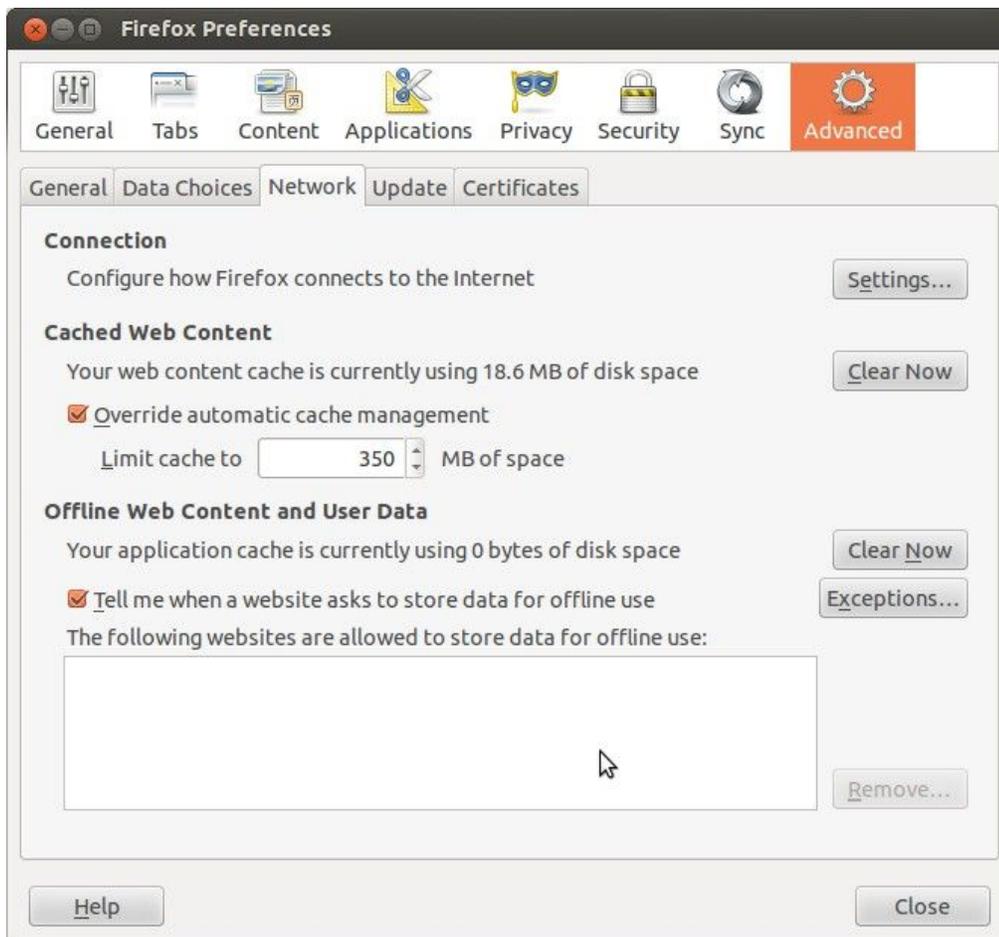


## Automatic Proxy Setting

To access online resources through the campus network, your network settings need to be configured to route network traffic through the college proxy server. You are reminded that all internet traffic to and from your device will be routed through the college proxy server. In case of internet service interruption, please restore your network settings accordingly. You don't need to connect to the proxy server if you are connected to the campus network.

### Firefox

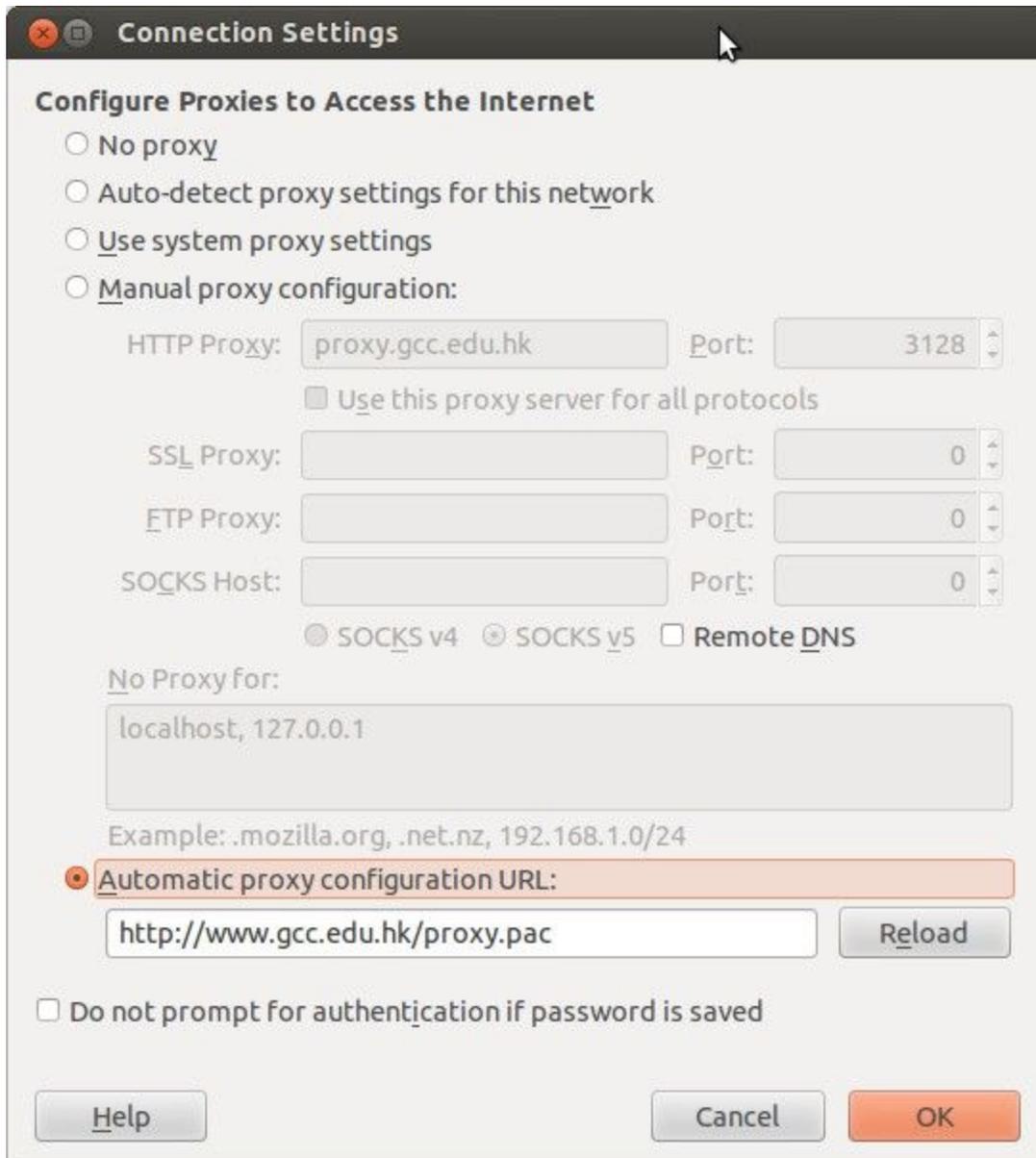
Show the Firefox Preferences dialog  
Select Advanced  
Select the Network tab  
You should see a dialog box similar to this



Click on [Settings...]



Select the radio button of "Automatic proxy configuration URL:"  
Enter the location of the PAC file. "http://www.gcc.edu.hk/proxy.pac"  
Click [OK] to close this dialog box.



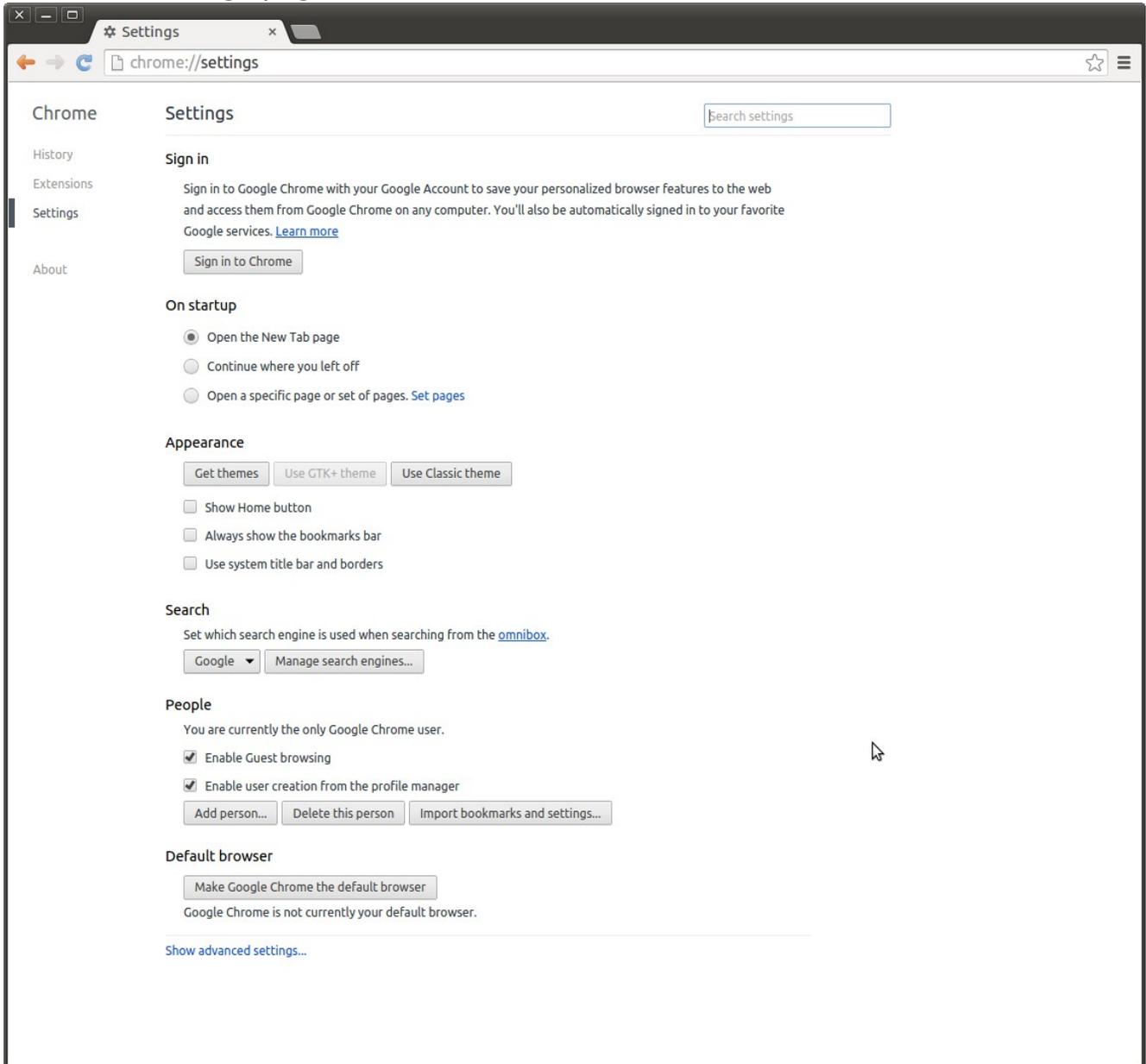
If you are not in the GCC Campus, you will be asked to authenticate yourself. Use your Linux username and password.

You are now connected to the Internet through GCC Proxy Server.

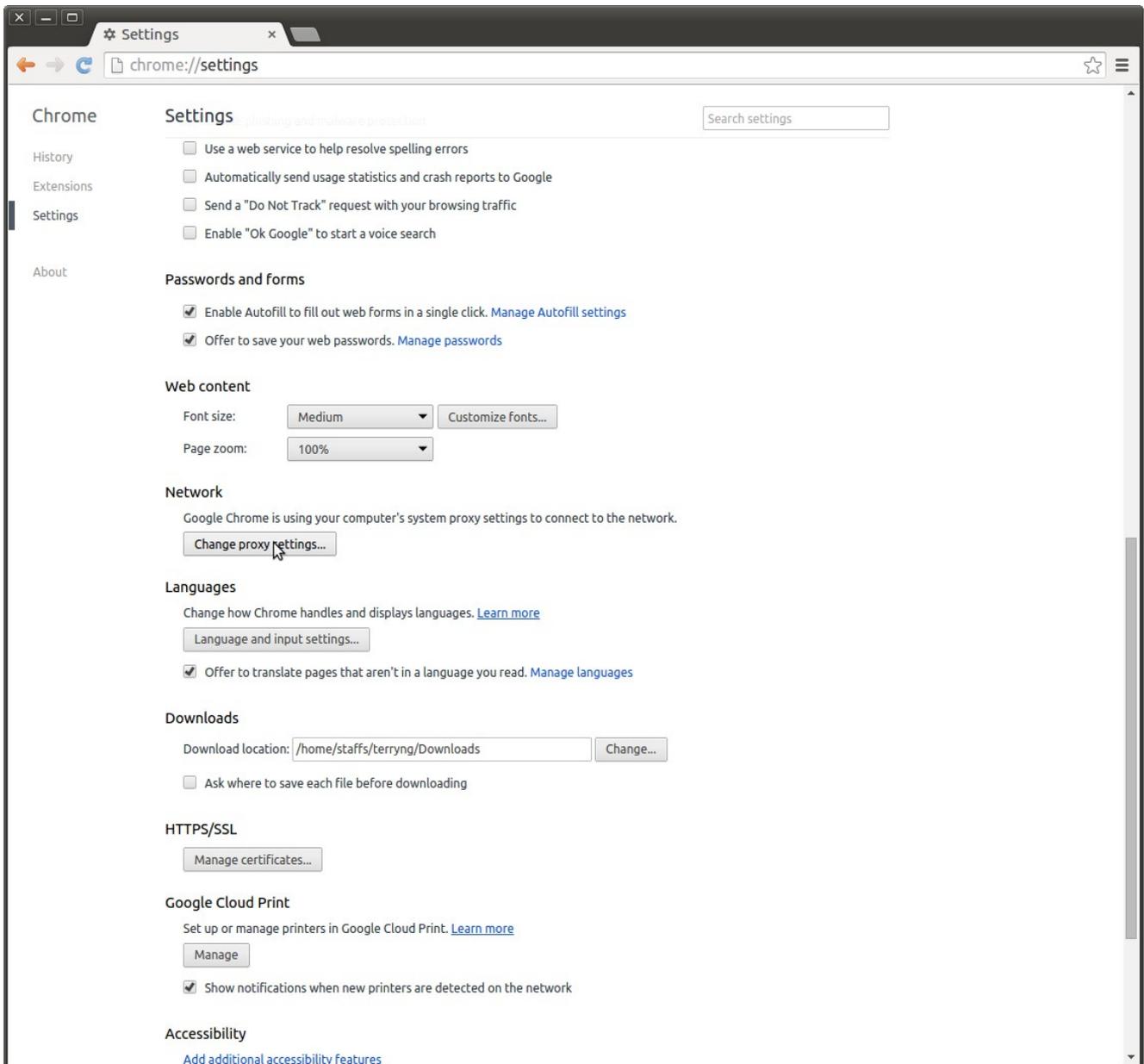

Click on "Show advanced settings" at the bottom of the page

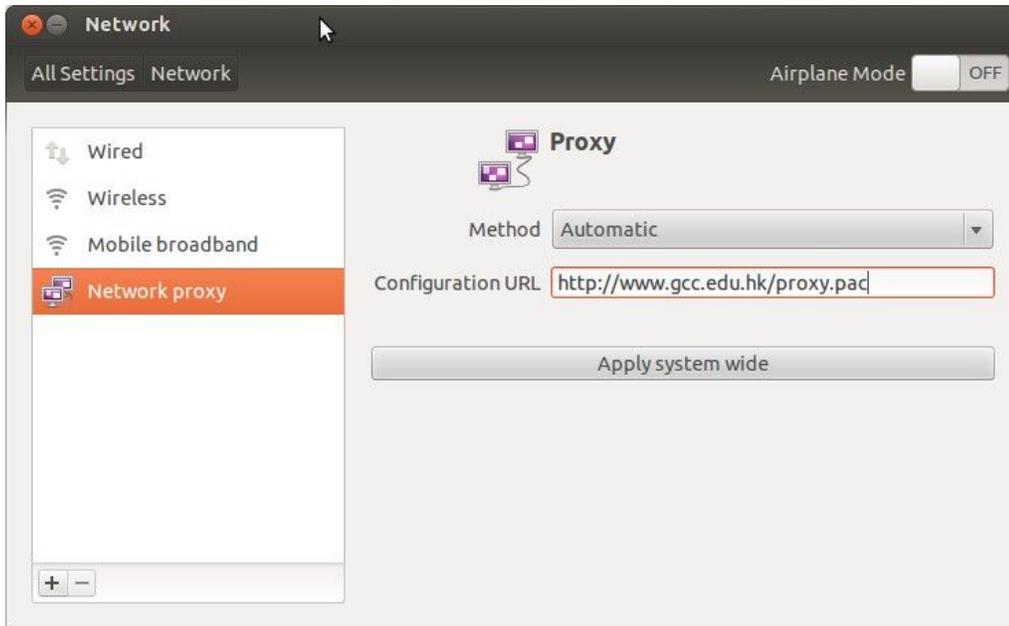


Under the Network heading, click on the [Change proxy settings]

Enter information as per the below picture

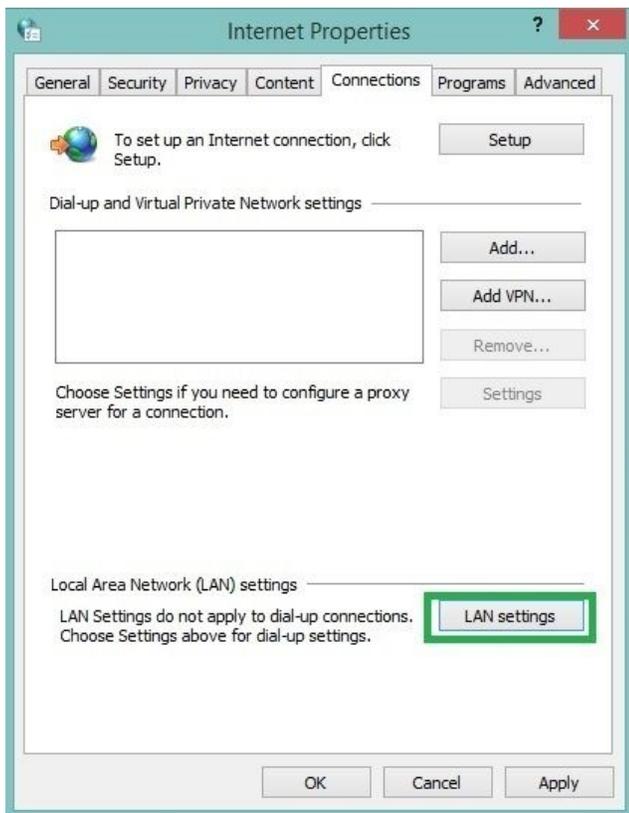

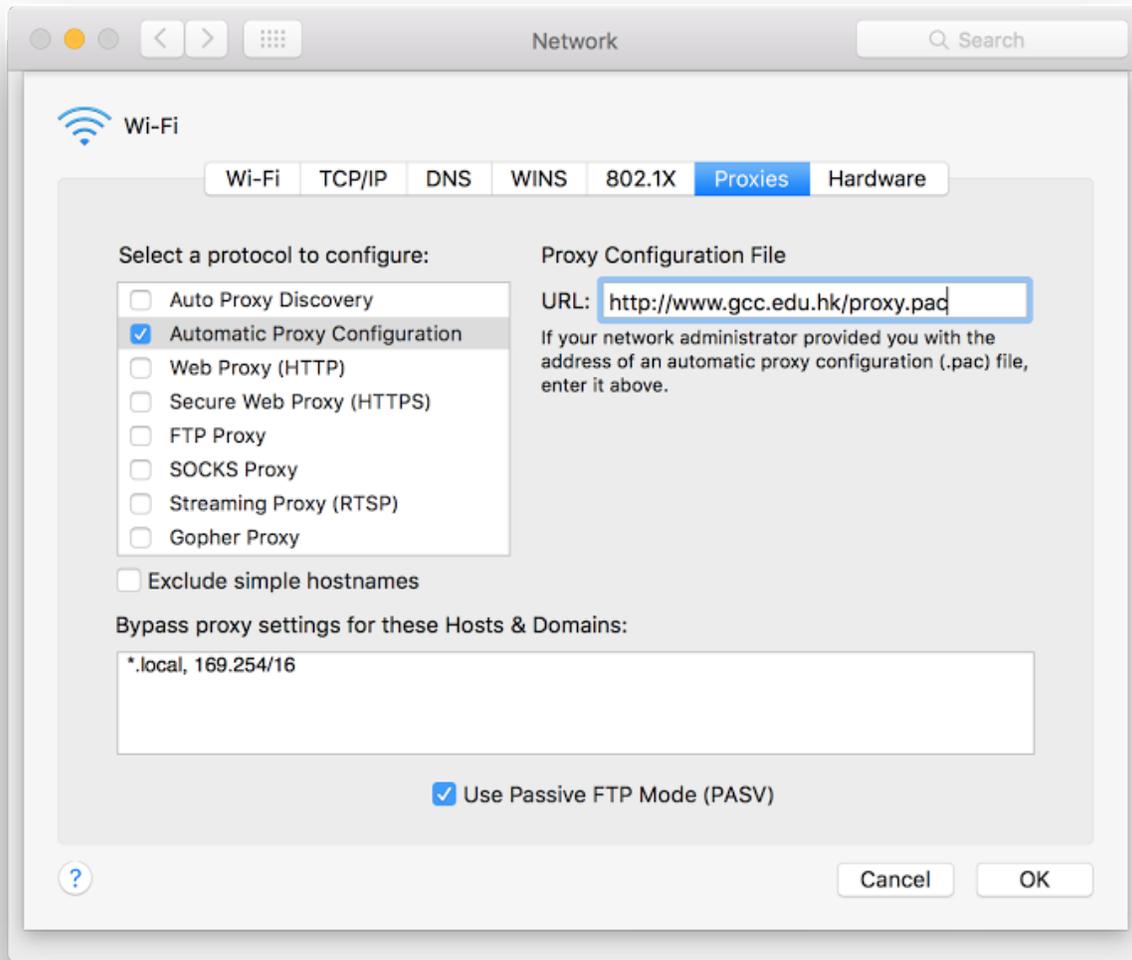

## **For Android OS – WiFi Connection**

1. Settings
2. Tap on WiFi
3. Press and hold on the connected wifi access point (usually the first one)
4. Tap on Modify Network (a setting dialog will show up)
5. Swipe up until you see "Show advanced options"
6. Check the box on the right of "Show advanced options"
7. Swipe up again until you see "PROXY SETTINGS"
8. Tap on None then select Manual
9. Swipe up again
10. Enter "proxy.gcc.edu.hk" into the "PROXY HOSTNAME" box
11. Enter "3128" into the "PROXY PORT" box
12. Tap [SAVE]

## **For Android OS – 3G/4G Data Connection**

1. Settings
2. Tap on More networks
3. Tap on Mobile networks
4. Tap on Access Point Names
5. Select your APN
6. Tap on Proxy then enter "proxy.gcc.edu.hk"
7. Tap on Port then enter "3128"

## iOS Device Settings

1. Open Settings



2. Tap on Wi-Fi.



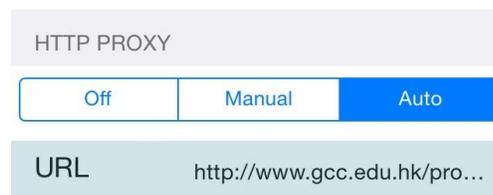
3. Tap on your network.
